[INTRODUCTORY NOTE]



I am also a professional actor and I have featured in several stage plays by the Chancellor College Travelling Theatre as well as a television drama series produced by the Story Workshop Education Trust.

Timasukirane Television Drama Series - Season 2 (2016) A National AIDS Commission (NAC) funded edutainment project, Timasukirane aimed at promoting self-efficacy among school-going and out of school youth with the view of protecting them from early pregnancy, early marriage and HIV/AIDS. I created, cowrote and directed all the 12 episodes of the series. In addition, I featured in the series as an actor. The series aired on MBC TV, Zodiak TV and Times TV.

Tilitonse (Deepening Democracy III) (2016 - 2017) With funding from Tilitonse Fund this was a Reality TV magazine programme that aimed at activating the urban citizenry to be able to demand better services, accountability and transparency from their duty-bearers. I produced and co-hosted the 52 episodes of the programme. The show aired on Zodiak TV and Times TV.

Lighthouse Docudramas (2018 - 2019) The docudramas were meant for PLWHA and they carried messages on Viral load, HIV and TB, HIV disclosure, EID and Treatment failure. I wrote and directed the 5 episodes of the docudramas. The docudramas are played in waiting bays of all Lighthouse Clinics in Malawi.

Afikepo/NAPE (2018 - 2021) Funded by the EU and the Germany Government through GIZ, this project aimed at promoting healthy nutrition and good hygiene practices among school-aged children. In 2018, I produced a video documentary which was showcased at the launch of the project. And in 2019, I produced 6 documentaries highlighting the project's success stories. In 2020-2021, I produced 28 radio magazine programmes and also produced 3 videos depicting success stories.

COVID-19 Social Media Awareness Campaign (2020) As part of the Covid-19 awareness campaign, I wrote and produced 4 influencer videos which were distributed on social media platforms. The influencers were renown musicians Che Wikise and Ketura, Sleak Tetti the comedian and Mr. Mike Mlobwa, Chairperson of the Indegenous Business Association.

Strengthening Fertilizer Systems through Promotion of Area Specific Fertilizer (2020 - 2021) I combined roles of project management and media production under this project. As project manager I was responsible for organizing community activities by facilitating community dialogues, roadshows and planning and writing reports. As a producer I was responsible for the production of 3 "Mlimi Wozitsata" video documentaries that aired on three national TV stations. The project was funded by AGRA.

InPATH (2019 - 2020)

I produced five educational videos on WASH for community cinemas targeting parents of under-five children and Skilled Birth Attendants. This project was funded by Cowater.

Zimachitika Radio Drama Serial (2019 - Present) Under the UNJPGE Project, I created, wrote and produced 27 episodes of the Zimachitika serial drama and they aired on MBC Radio 1 and two other community radio stations of Mangochi and Salima. The project sought to reduce school dropouts among girls. The series is now extended to 30 more episodes under UNICEF nutrition project of which I am the writer and producer.

Maphunziro Ulalo Wathu Radio Programme (2020 - Present) I co-host in this radio programme which focuses on capacity building for teacher trainees. I have also been involved in the development of promotion and communication strategy for the radio programmes.

UBALE (Theatre for Development Project) (2016 - 2017) I was involved in the development of the TfD training manual and also facilitated workshops in the rural areas of Chikwawa.

Action Aid Joint TB and HIV Programme (2017)

As part of community mobilisation activities, I helped to train rural drama clubs in Theatre for Development. The project was funded by GLOBAL Fund.
